This project paired ten For All Seasons clients with personal experience and knowledge of rape and sexual abuse with ten professional artists from the Mid-Shore for the purpose of participating in a two-day art-making workshop. The artists were carefully selected on the basis of their sensitivity, knowledge of materials and art processes.

This event, co-created and led by artists Pamela Berry and Pamela Toll, provided participants with opportunities for intimate self-expression and potential healing and transformation through art. Printmaking and additive sculpture were chosen as the vehicle to permit For All Seasons clients and artists to create openly and safely with an emphasis on materials and process. This pointed the way to their illuminating self-portraits, free of predictability and charged with authenticity, as you will see in the powerful exhibition.
